## INTRODUCTION

This quartedly report of the Trade and Industrial Development Program covers the period April Brough June 1993 and contains information drawn from the TID Program Tradeing Component of the Flanning and Tradeing Spaces. The report is based on the returns that were available up to October 20, 1993, from a right of eighty-two (E3) missions in all five major regions abroad.

There are two ratio sections to this report:

Section I, immediately following, consists of six program results summeries; one for each major region and one for "All Regions", i.e. a global summary. Each page summerizes a respective region:

- business activity reported and highlights of that activity;
  - key statistics on trade and investment enquiries;
    - number of business visitors.

Section II, contains an "A ctivity Report" for each region and its respective posts. The format of these is identical throughout this section, regardless of the level of peographic aggregation. "Activity" on these reports is broken down into TID program activity (items A through I) and activity relating to other mission programs (item K). For each activity them is an indication of the average time spent on the Trade Program by Canada-based and Locally engaged trade program officers. There is also a "total time allocation" for each activity which should be read as an indicates of program officer person-year. Finally, each report indicates workload by activity. Tourism activities are also included in this report.
