

ARTICLE 9

Security

Thailand shall take security measures to prevent the disclosure by a trainee, after the cessation of his training, to any other government or to any unauthorized person of classified Canadian information of which he may become cognizant in his capacity as a trainee.

ARTICLE 10

Claims

Canada waives all claims against Thailand for losses of, or damage to, any property owned or used by Canada where such loss or damage is caused by a trainee acting in the course of his official duties and where there is no evidence of neglect or malice on the part of the trainee.

ARTICLE 11

Canada and Thailand waive all claims against each other for injury or death suffered by a trainee or a member of the Canadian Forces while either is engaged in the performance of his official duties. Where a claim is made against Canada by any person for the injury or death suffered by a trainee in the performance of his duties, Thailand shall indemnify Canada in respect of costs incurred and damages paid by Canada in dealing with such a claim.
