

that supplies are fairly distributed and well protected; that pilferage is unknown; that warehouse arrangements, internal transport and the preparation and distribution of meals are being conducted with exceptional efficiency, and that the staff in the field are working with great devotion and confidence.

Despite generous contributions, the Fund is at present unable to reach more than a small fraction of the needy children in Europe and the Far East and does not have sufficient resources to maintain even this through 1948.
