

1967 Universal and International Exposition in Montreal (Expo 67). This participation is bound to have a favourable effect on Canadian-Soviet relations. Both sides were convinced that the ties developed in this way would further develop for the benefit of the two countries and that this would make a contribution to the strengthening of world peace and understanding between peoples.

The Canadian delegation expressed gratitude for the hospitality of their Soviet hosts. Mr. Macnaughton, Speaker of the House of Commons, extended a cordial and formal invitation to the USSR Supreme Soviet to send a Soviet parliamentary delegation to Canada. The invitation was accepted by the Supreme Soviet of the USSR with satisfaction. The sides agreed that the exact date of this visit to Canada would be fixed through diplomatic channels. "
