We appreciate the need to avoid any impression that the DAC is interfering with their work, but the DAC has a legitimate role to play in assembling information on the related activities of the various bilateral and multilateral programmes. In our view, the words of the recommendation strike the right note and are an excellent example of the unique role which the DAC can play in assisting member governments to make an effective appraisal of important development problems.
