In other respects, Canada is interested in the transportation problems facing Niger, for example the construction of the "highway of unity" and the improvement of the transport system towards the sea, and foresees a joint effort by the two countries in this field. The President and the Prime Minister also examined a project for establishing a regional bilingual institute at Niamey.

The President invited the Canadian Prime Minister to visit Niger in the near future.

The Prime Minister took pleasure in emphasizing the importance of President Diouri Hamani's visit which would give millions of Canadians an opportunity to learn more about Niger as a key country in the heart of the African continent.
