Mr. Robb moved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the following proposed Resolution:-

That the Governor in Council be authorized to raise by way of loan under the provisions of the Consolidated Revenue and Audit Act such sum or sums of money as may be required, not to exceed in the whole the sum of five hundred million dollars, for paying or redeeming the whole or any portion of loans or obligations of Canada and for purchasing and withdrawing from circulation unmatured securities of Canada; the principal and interest to be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Whereupon, Mr. Robb, a Member of the King's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the said proposed Resolution.

Mr. Robb moved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the following proposed Resolution:-

That the Dominion Notes Act be amended to provide that the Governor in Council may establish branch offices of the Department of Finance for the redemption of Dominion notes (in addition to those already authorized), at such other place or places in Canada as the Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Treasury Board, may authorize.

Whereupon, Mr. Robb, a Member of the King's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the said proposed Resolution.

Mr. Malcolm moved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the following proposed Resolution:-

That it is expedient to amend and revise the Electricity Inspection Act to bring it into conformity with the existing conditions in electricity, in regard to the commercial unit of supply, the units of electrical measure, inspection standards, the verification of meters, and other related matters, and to provide for the appointment of a Director and such assistants as may be deemed necessary.

Whereupon, Mr. Malcolm, a Member of the King's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole, to-morrow, to consider the said proposed Resolution.
