tract and December 31, 1966, and the United Kingdom atomic energy authority agreed to advance an additional \$1.50 for each pound delivered to them in the period January 1, 1965, to December 31, 1966; payment of the advance to be made on the date on which the pound would have been delivered under the original contract. These advance payments are interest free.

67. From the point of view of attaining the objectives, the offer to the Canadian industry has been eminently successful. Monthly deliveries began to decrease early in 1960 and are now scheduled to continue well into 1966. A complete collapse of the industry between March 1962 and March 1963 will have been avoided. Provided no other sales are made, the following are the closing dates of the various operations:

68. The foregoing takes into consideration only the known factors in the situation. Strenuous efforts are being made to develop other markets and new uses for uranium, which, together with the developing requirements of the world's nuclear power programs, should have some favourable effect before the last of the deliveries under the present firm contracts have been completed.

That completes Eldorado Mining and Refining. We will now proceed to the

subsidiary companies.

Mr. Dumas: Before you do that, may I ask a question. Do you propose to say something on exploration?

Mr. GILCHRIST: Not any more really than what I have said, in general.

Mr. Dumas: But, you are conducting explorations?

Mr. Gilchrist: We have been up until now, but we have postponed our program now for this year. We have suspended it for the time being, and we will not be in it for this coming season.
