## FORM OF A BILL TO AMEND AN ACT

611: B. 232, 236, 583.

60a. (1) In the preparation of Bills Form of a Bill to amend amending existing enactments the amendments an Act. shall not ordinarily be made by clauses which add or leave out words or substitute words for others, but by clauses which re-enact the section, subsection or other minor division, as it is amended.
