--5. The Executive Committee authorized Professor MacKenzie to make this request, on the understanding that the grants were not conditional on any money being raised by the Canadian Institute. VIII. PROGRADED FOR SIMPH I. P. R. CONFERENCE. It was decided to defer consideration of this matter until a later meeting. IX. FORMATION OF BRANCH IN QUIBBLE CITY. The Secretary reported that on his visit to Quebec City, Fr. Louis St. Laurent, he laive a luncheon at which he had met some twelve persons, and that at this luncheon it had been decided to form a branch of the Institute in Quebec City. This roup had appointed Col. C. A. Chauveau and Er. Garon Pratte as their Temporary Chairman and Temporary Secretary, respectively. The Executive Committee expressed its pleasure at the progress which had been made and elected Col. Chauveau and Ir. Pratte to membership in the Institute and in the Council. X. CONSIDERATION OF WORLHAPTON OF MR. L'ON L'ANDE. Mr. Leon Lalande, of Windsor, Ont., having been nominated to membership by Mr. Paul Hartin and Fr. Dscott Reid, and his nomination havin been approved of by Mr. Rowell and Mr. Macdonnell, was slected by the Committee as a member-at-lar e of the Institute.
