
Dear Sir Arthur:

It is unnecessary for me to elaborate upon the problem of accommodation which this Department is facing at the present time. The situation is very acute, our students are forced to dress in corridors and in very unhygienic locker rooms, and the time table for all phases of our work is extremely complex, adding a great deal of time and attention to the problem of adequate supervision.

I am given to understand that there is a possibility of the Arts Building being remodelled this spring. As you know this will seriously affect this Department and as far as my Budget is concerned for the coming session I can merely go ahead on the assumption that approximately the same expenditure will be required next year as in the current session.

The attached resolution is forwarded to you, it having been unanimously passed by the Executive Committee of the School of Physical Education at its last meeting held on March 17th, 1925.
