

CONSTITUTION,
BY-LAWS,

CONSTITUTION.

1.—The corporate name of this Association shall be the
 "LONDON MASONIC MUTUAL BENEFIT ASSOCIATION."

2.—The object of the Association shall be for making
 provision by means of contributions, subscriptions, dona-
 tions, or otherwise against bodily disability resulting
 from the loss of sight, hand, arm or leg, or from severe
 spinal injury, and against death; and for relieving the
 members and the widows and orphan children of deceased
 members.

3.—The character of the Association shall be purely
 mutual.

4.—It shall consist of several classes of members; the
 maximum number of members of the first of such classes
 shall be two thousand and five hundred, and the maximum
 number of any subsequent class shall be one thousand;
 but no such subsequent class shall be formed before the
 preceding class has reached its maximum number of
 members.

5.—The officers of the Association shall be: a President,
 a Vice-President, six Directors, a Secretary, a Treasurer
 and two Auditors. The President, Vice-President and
 the Directors shall, jointly, form a Board of Directors,
