within the Diocese of Quebec,—the erection and maintenance of Parsonage Houses,—the setting apart of Burial Grounds and Church-yards,—and the Endowment and support of Parsonages and Rectories, according to the said Establishment within the said Diocese.

III. A Devise of Real Estate for the general purposes of the Society.

I give and devise unto the "Church Society of the Diocese of Quebec," incorporated by a Statute of the Province of Canada, passed in the seventh year of the Reign of Her Majesty, QUEEN VICTORIA, all and singular, &c. (Describe the Real Estate clearly.) To have and to hold the said, &c. unto the said Church Society of the Diocese of Quebec, and their successors, for ever; upon trust to hold and apply the same, and the rents, issues and profits thereof, to and for the uses and purposes of the said Church Society, as specified in the said Act of Incorporation, and none other, and under the provisions of the aforesaid Act of Incorporation of the said Church Society.

V. A Devise to the Society of a Site for a Church, &c.

Same as No. 3, down to the words "for ever"—then go on as follows:—to the uses and upon the trusts following, that is to say: Upon trust to hold the same for ever hereafter, as and for the place and Site of a Church and Church-yard, and Burial Ground, for the sole use and benefit of members of the United Church of England and Ireland, residing in places adjacent to the said site and premises within the said Diocese of Quebec, being in full communion with the same, according to the doctrines and discipline of the said United Church of England and Ireland, and for no other purpose, and under the provisions of the aforesaid Act of Incorporation of the said Church Society.
