that the Profecution of my Defign to treat of the System of our great Boards at Home, upon the Knowle' of which much depends, cannot draw their Resentment upon me ; but if, contrary to my Expectation, any Perfon in Power takes Offence at my Conduct, I humbly hope that on due Reflection they will change their Sentiments. And that fuch of our young Senators, who may take the Trouble to read this Difcourfe, will be pleafed to accept of my Endeavours to explain to them the System of our American Offices, from which great Advantages may arife to this Kingdom in the future Conduct of our Affairs.
