- The Service shall be the same with the usual Office for rioly-days, except where it is in this Office otherwise appointed.
- Let him that ministereth read with a loud Voice these Sentences of Scripture; and after them the Exhortation, Dearly beloved Brethren, &c.

Turn Thee, O Lord, and deliver my foul: O save me for Thy Plate mercies Jake.
