¶ *The Service shall be the same with the usual Office for Holy-days, except where it is in this Office otherwise appointed.*

¶ *Let him that ministereth read with a loud Voice these Sentences of Scripture ; and after them the Exhortation, Dearly beloved Brethren, &c.*

I WILL arise and go to my Father ; and will say unto him, *St.*
 Father, I have sinned against Heaven, and before Thee, *xv*
 and am no more worthy to be called Thy Son.

If we say that we have no sin we deceive ourselves, and the *s*
 truth is not in us : But if we confess our sins, He is faithful *i. 8*
 and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all
 unrighteousness.

HEAR our Prayer, O God : and hide not Thyself from *Psa*
 our Petition. *lv.*

Take heed unto us and hear us : how we mourn in our Prayer *Psa*
and are vexed. *lv.*

Unto Thee will I cry, O Lord, my strength : think no scorn *Psa*
 of me, lest if Thou make, as though Thou hearest not, I be- *xxv*
 come like them that go down into the Pit.

Turn Thee, O Lord, and deliver my soul : O save me for Thy *Psa*
 mercies sake. *vi.*
