ANOTHER ADVANCE BY CANADA BREAD

Atlantic Sugar Issues, Canadian Locomotive and Spanish River Also Features.

Various industrial stocks showed a good deal of animation in the trading on the Toronto Exchange yesterday, and, with transactions in listed issues approaching the 3400-mark, the day was one of the most active of the year to date. Canada Bread, the Atlantic Sugar stocks, Canadian Locomotive and Spanish River were all dealt in briskly, and showed a strong tone, while Canada Steamships preferred, which had been steadily moving upward on steady accumulation, broke loose with a sharp advance to the highest point locally in two years. A number of other issues, while not dealt in to any marked extent, exhibited a distinctly firm tone including Mackay, Maple Leaf and General Electric.

Canada Bread, which rose 1%, to 23½, the highest level in some time, and closed at the top, owed its buoyancy to the intimation that there will be an increase in the price of bread to the consumer as a result of the granting by the company of the demands of employes for higher wages. The Atlantic Sugar stocks, which have been moving forward for some weeks, with an occasional pause to consolidate gains, exhibited prohounced strength. Ten shares of the common came out at 30½, an advance of a point, and the bid was then advanced to 31½, with the stock held at 22½. Canadian Locomotive was in request around 68, an advance of about a point, and Spanish River, reflecting a further upturn in Montreal, sold here at 22½, a gain of a point.
