WILL BUILD NEW HOTEL AS PLANNED

W. S. Dinick Emphatically Denies Report From Court of Revision.

DELAY IN FINANCING

Those Interested Never Had Any Intention of Dropping Project and Haven't.

Emphatically declaring that an hotel will be built on the ground occupied by the Yonge Street Arcade and attributing the delay to the necessary details involved in developing finances, W. S. GET PAY OF A SOLDIER

More Than a Million Men Now in Service of Empire's Watchdog.

There are now 5,000 overseas troops stationed in Toronto for training. With the arrival tomorrow of 150 Artillery men, members of the 67th, 69th, 70th and 1st Depot Batteries from Potawawam, Canada, the total of active service troops quartered in this city will pass the 6,000 mark.

In Exhibition Camp there are already 4,100 soldiers, and in school quarters in the city proper, 1,900 more. The troops at Exhibition Camp include the Divisional Cyclists, under Capt. W. A. Kyle; 18th Buffs, Lt.-Col. J. A. Campbell; 20th Irish Canadians, Lt.-Col. T. H. Lennox; 25th York, Lt.-Col. E. Price; 28th Irish Canadians, Lt.-Col. W. Wallace; Army Service Corps, Depot, Major J. C. Allan; Army Veterinary Corps, Capt. F. S. Macdonald; No. 2 Signal Coy., Lt.-Col. J. M. Kane. In the city the 21st Battalion, Battalion are quartered in Jesse Ketchum School, under Lt.-Col. F. L.
