

SOCIETY FOLK LEAVE DANCE

TO FIGHT FIRE New York, Jan. 3.—New Year's toll of casualties from poisonous liquor last night mounted to four dead and six very still, with uncounted scores of cases of acute alcoholism and accidents attributed to holiday liquor.

New York, Jan. 3.—Society men and women hurriedly left the ballroom of the Historic Westchester Country Club yesterday, formed a bucket brigade and worked for nearly an hour in a temperature around ten above zero in an ineffectual attempt to save the structure. It was burned to the ground. Women managed to save tapestries, paintings and furniture valued at thousands of dollars. The loss by fire is estimated at \$250,000.
