BUSINESS CONDITIONS.

The Bank of Commerce report on
Canadian business conditions for the
month of July makes the following in-
teresting comment: No important
changes occurred in the general indus-
trial situation during July. While in
some districts factories closed, in others
greater activity was reported, but on
the whole fewer hands were employed
than at the same period a year ago. Or-
ders from retailers continue to be of a
hand-to-mouth character and consum-
ers are displaying similar caution. The
severe decline in prices of agricultural
products has resulted in a diminished
volume of purchases by farmers, who
are not adding to their plant by way of
new implements or buildings, but are
pursuing the same cautious policy in this
respect as in the case of personal re-
quirements. Prices of agricultural pro-
ducts now average 37 per cent in ex-
cess of the prices of 1914, whereas prices
of many of the requirements of the
farmers still remain 100 per cent, in ex-
cess of the average for 1914. Under such
conditions it cannot be expected that
the farmers will be liberal purchasers,
nor are they likely to be until there is
a general re-adjustment of prices. The
most hopeful feature of the situation is
the outlook on the prairie provinces for
a yield of wheat which may reach be-
tween 250 and 260 million bushels.

MRS. NELLIE MCCLUNG.
(Montreal Herald.)
Among the striking personalities en-
tering upon public life, as the outcome
of the recent provincial election in Al-
berta, is Mrs. Nellie McClung, long
known as a pleasing writer. Her first
book, "Sowing Seeds in Danny" was
written in an original, breezy style
which won attention and was followed
by "The Second Chance," which caught
the public. As a forceful public
speaker and lecturer, a vigorous tem-
perance advocate and an active Metho-
dist, Mrs. McClung has been a person to be
recounted with in the west. Her plat-
form activities have favored the Lib-
eral party and now she enters the legis-
lature as a supporter of that party. Her
campaign was opened on the same plat-
form with Premier Stewart, and what-
ever may be his future, Mrs. McClung
takes her seat in the provincial legis-
lature as a Liberal. In the early days
of the west, a Canadian Irish family
named Mooney migrated to the coun-
try beyond Winnipeg, and Nellie was
one of the little girl members of that
Owen Sound, Ontario, family. In due
time the little girl became a teacher,
then a contributor to the Boston
Youth's Companion, and a Canadian
periodical literature and the writer of
books. Incidentally the writer and
teacher became Mrs. McClung and the
mother of four charming children. An
attractive, resourceful person, a fluent
and pleasant speaker, Mrs. McClung will
be welcomed to the public life of
Canada.
