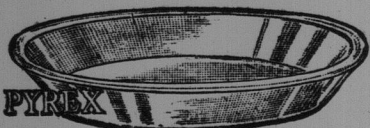

by the conference on Finland's admission appeal would be taken to the permanent court of international justice. The court has not yet been organized but is provided for in the treaty of peace. Sir Malcolm opposed the admission of Finland on the ground that it would read into the treaty a meaning not intended by the powers which signed it.

Government delegates from Norway, Sweden and Denmark supported the request of Finland.

In the commission on hours of work labor delegates opposed a declaration in favor of a forty-eight hour week without guarantee that the maximum working day would be eight hours. No definite action was taken.

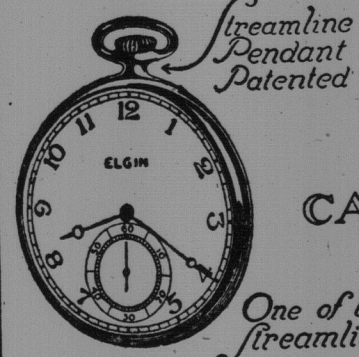
