Daily Hints For the Cook

Plum Jelly

Cover plums which are not quite ripe with boiling water, let simmer until soft, then drain in a jelly bag. Measure the juice and to each pint of juice allow a pound of sugar. Boil the juice in a preserving kettle for five minutes, add the sugar, which should be warmed in the oven, stir until dissolved, then continue the boiling until it will jelly when dropped on a cold plate. Turn into glasses and seal when cold.

Snow Pudding Made Without Gelatine

Three tablespoons cornstarch dissolved in a little water, one-half cup of sugar. Add one pint of boiling water, cook about 20 minutes. Let cool, add beaten whites of three eggs and juice of two small lemons. Beat 10 minutes. It will thicken up after setting over night. Take the yolks with a quart of milk and make a custard to pour over it.





London, Oct. 9.—Mrs. Laura Gallagher, Cliswell, who saved her life when threatened by her now dead husband's revolver, was suffering from shock to-day and was in a serious condition, her friends said. She was in no danger, however, early today. The cause of her attack of nervous prostration came suddenly early Sunday morning, when her husband pulled his wife from bed saying "Your time has come." GERMAN SOLDIERS INVADING FRANCE ARE REPULSED BY BAR MINE

Brsay, France, Oct. 9.—There was an other Franco-German episode in this frontier town on Saturday.

Early in the morning the people became excited when some German troops galloped in on French territory. They remained until evening, when they were invited to leave.

MISSIONARIES ALIVE, WOMEN UNHARMED

According to Message From American Minister in Hu-Peh—Hope to Hold Bandits

Pekin, Oct. 9.—A message dated October 8 was received today at Siang Yang-Fu, in Hu-Peh province from the Rev. Christian Stokstad and the Rev. Mr. Johnson, the two American missionaries trying to negotiate with the Chinese bandits for the release of the American and Norwegian missionaries held in captivity by the bandits at Tsaoyang. It says that three white women and two children are at the bandits' headquarters and have not been harmed, while the men are believed to be living.

This message appears to discredit the report that the little son of the Rev. Mr. Fauske and Mrs. Fauske has been killed.

The Rev. C. Stokstad and the Rev. Mr. Johnson express the hope that the force of 1,800 troops round Tsaoyang will be able to hold the bandits until reinforcements arrive. The bandits number about 1,000 of whom half are mounted.
