Avily's Gay Lady, and third to Mr. McAvity's Garter.
Class C, Sec. 1—Saddle horse, ridden by gentleman—H. H. Learmonth's horse won first; D. C. Clinch's Brownstone, second; W. J. Pearson (Montreal), 3rd. The others were Nellie C. John H. Bond; Islington, W. S. Allison; Jim J. B. Gillespie's horse shown by Mrs. Guy Hart, Halifax.
Class A, Sec. 3—Harness horse, to appropriate vehicle, over 15 1/2 hands, either light or heavy harness. The entries were Lethure and Princess, C. E. Sarnbon, Lewiston Junction; Black Hawk, George W. Fowler, Sussex; and a horse shown by H. H. Learmonth, Montreal.
Class C, Sec. 3—Jumping, saddle, heavy weight, ridden by gentleman—Ensign's Nellie C. J. H. Bond, Islington, W. S. Allison; Guardian, George W. Fowler, Sussex; Chief Clark; Hinta, J. D. Reid; Debarrie, Mr. McKinnon, Halifax; Queen Louise, F. L. Fuller, Truro; and F. M. Gillespie; Nellie C. The first horse to try, declined the first jump three times. Mr. Clinch sent Guardian over at the first try, but the horse knocked down the bar on the second and third attempts. Islington went nicely, but struck the bar the third and fourth times. Mr. Gillespie's Jim, ridden by H. H. Learmonth, cleared the first bar, but on the second time failed at the second time, but struck after getting over. The third and fourth time he sent the bar down. Mr. McKinnon's horse came very slowly to the bar, but he knocked it down every time. Chief Clark's horse failed at the first and second, but his jockey nicely put him over at the third attempt. Islington went nicely over the first time, failed on the second, took the third nicely and the fourth in fine style. H. H. Learmonth's mount took the first bar easily, also the second and third and fourth.
Anita, a small horse, took the first bar but the second, third and fourth attempts. Queen Louise took the first but missed the second; cleared the third and fourth neatly.
The bar was raised higher. Islington went over once but failed the second time. Guardian failed twice; Mr. Pearson's horse the same. H. H. Learmonth took the first, but hit the bar the second time. Anita, the second, took the first; Mr. Learmonth's horse took first prize; Mr. Fuller's, second; Mr. Pearson's horse, third, and Islington, the judge said, would have been fourth on points.
Class 8, Sec. 4, single driving horse, mare or gelding, light harness—H. H. Learmonth's Lulu Lamps won first prize; W. J. Pearson's, second; and Nellie C. John H. Bond's Black Sheep, third. The others were Frank P. Kierin's Doc, J. B. Gillespie's John, and R. T. Worden's horse.
In this class there were some lively brushes between Black Sheep and Lulu Lamps.
Class 7, Sec. 11, four-hand heavy harness—The former won first prize.
Class 9, ladies' saddle, the horses entered were: Mrs. J. A. McKinnon's (Halifax), and Mrs. Guy Hart's (Halifax). The former won first and the latter second.
A potato race on horseback caused a lot of interest and some excitement. There were seven entries. The competitors were to gallop, pick up the potato in one hand, place and ride to a basket on another part of the track and there put the potato; repeating this twice. Those entered were: Sgt. THE PONIES.

The pony exhibit came next with three entries. The youthful drivers got a great reception when they appeared before the grand stand with their pretty rigs. The first prize went easily to the pony entered by David Russell, Jr., and when he accepted the red ribbon and dashed proudly off at a canter, there was a storm of applause from the grand stand. The second prize went to Jack Knight's Fan; and the third to H. J. Pullen's Paddy.
In class seven, four-hand, matched teams, heavy harness, there were five entries and handsome rigs they were. The first prize went to Sarnbon, the second to Learmonth, and the third to Pearson. S. Allison's Islington, ridden by Mrs. C. Kinross, of Halifax; the second to D. C. Clinch's Brownstone, ridden by Mrs. C. E. Hart, of Halifax; and the third to John H. Bond's Nellie C. ridden by Mrs. Carter. The other entry was Chief Clark's horse, ridden by Miss Markham. It was in this exhibition the thrilling experience of Mrs. McKinnon occurred.
Tug-of-War on Horseback.
The next event was a tug-of-war on horseback, by two teams of four each. The team were troopers of the Hussars. Sgt. Porter, with James Sproul, James Izard and Fitzgerald, won from Sgt. Porter, with McKenna, Ryder and Smith. Several men were unhorsed, and the event was intensely amusing, the crowd hugely enjoying the fun.
The last competition was for matched team, light harness. There were only two entries. The first prize went to W. H. Barnaby's team, and the second to that of Holmes Bros., of Amherst.

THE LIVE STOCK

The Display Large and Quality Excellent—Some Records of Judging.
The judging of light and heavy draught horses began at 9 a.m. and A. P. Ketchum, B. S. A., Ottawa, was judge of the heavy draughts, while C. C. Gardner, of Charlottetown (P. E. I.), gave the decision re-

arding the light draughts. The animals shown were a very creditable lot, and those looking on expressed themselves as highly pleased. Mr. Ketchum gave it his opinion that in the medium draughts the teams were by far the strongest quality. Mr. Gardner, whose experience is also of much value, was very favorably impressed.

The cattle judging attracted a much larger crowd than at previous exhibitions. This was no doubt owing to the superior quality of animals shown. The judging of live stock included Shorthorns, Jerseys, Cotswolds, Leicesters, Lincolns, Berkshires and Chester Whites. Much deliberation had to be given before decisions were arrived at, because of the keen competition. Special mention must be made regarding the magnificent lot of Shorthorn cattle shown by Senator Edwards, of Ontario, amongst which is one animal weighing 2100. This animal is worthy of every visitor's attention. There is also a bull calf, and a two-year-old heifer, each of which took first prize at the Toronto fair. Mr. Edwards intends to sell his entire stock in January, and is therefore exhibiting for that reason alone. He accepts no prize money. The yearling bull and yearling heifer shown by Lieut. Governor Snowball are splendid animals. They were bred by G. A. Archibald, of Toronto (N. S.), who is also exhibitor.
