

que quede en perpetua memoria, hago notorio y manifiesto a los Reyes, Príncipes, Potentados, Repúblicas, Comunidades, y personas particulares que son y fueren en los Siglos venideros, que siendo unos de los principales Supuestos de los Tratados de Pazes Pendientes entra la Corona de *España* y la de *Francia*, con la de *Inglatera*, para Zimentar la firme y permanente, y proceder á la General sobre la maxima de asegurar con perpetuidad el universal Bien, y quietud de la *Europa* en un Equilibrio de Potencias, desuerte que unidas Muchas in Una, no declinaze la Valanza de la deseada igualdad, en ventaja de una apeligo y recelo de las demás: Se propuso y infistó por la *Inglatera*, y se combino por mi parte, y la del Rey mi Abuelo, que para evitar in qualquier Tiempo la Union de esta Monarchia y la de *Francia*, y la posibilidad de que in ningun Caso subcediese, se hiziesen reciprocas renuncias por mi, y toda mi descendencia á la Subcesion posible de la Monarchia de *Francia*, y por la de aquellos Príncipes y todas sus Lineas existentes y futuras a la de este Monarchia, formando

publicis, Communitatibus, & privatis personis, praesentibus & futuris, notum facio & manifestum: Cum una sit ex præcipuis positionibus *Treatatus Pacis*, de quâ inter Coronam *Hispæniae*, & Coronam *Gallie*, cum Coronâ *Angliae* in praesenti agitur, ad eam firmam & stabilem coagimentandam, & generali promovendam, positum fundamento in Potentiarum æquilibrio, Bonum universale & Tranquillitatem publicam perpetuò firmandi; ne plures unitæ simul Potestates exoptati æquilibrii Trutinam, ad unius utilitatem, & aliorum timorem & discrimen trahant: *Anglia* constituit, & eâ flagitante ex Nostrâ, Regisque Abavi nostri partibus, conventum est, quod ad hujus Monarchiæ cum illâ *Gallie* unionem quoconque tempore evitandam, & Successionem in quolibet Casu impossibilem reddendam, reciprocæ pro Nobis & Descendentibus nostris, possibili Monarchiæ *Gallie* Successioni, & ex parte Principum *Gallie*, & omnium eorundem Linearum existentium, & futurarum hujus Monarchiæ Successioni renunciations fieri deberent; formando abdicationes omnium Jurium, quæ utraque Domus Re-

to Kings, Princes, Potentates, Commonwealths, Communities, and particular Persons, which now are, and shall be in future Ages: That it being one of the principal Positions of the Treaties of Peace, depending between the Crowns of *Spain*, and of *France*, with that of *England*, for the rendering it firm and lasting, and proceeding to a general one, on the Maxim of securing for ever the universal Good and Quiet of *Europe*, by an equal Weight of Power, so that many being united in one, the Balance of the Equality desired, might not turn to the Advantage of one, and the Danger and Hazard of the rest; It was proposed, and insisted on by *England*, and it was agreed to on my part, and on that of the King my Grandfather, That for avoiding at any time whatever the Union of this Monarchy, with that of *France*, and the possibility that it might happen in any case, reciprocal Renunciations should be made by me, and for all my Descendants, to the possibility of succeeding to the Monarchy of *France*, and on the part of those Princes, and of all their Race, present and to come, to that of succeed-
