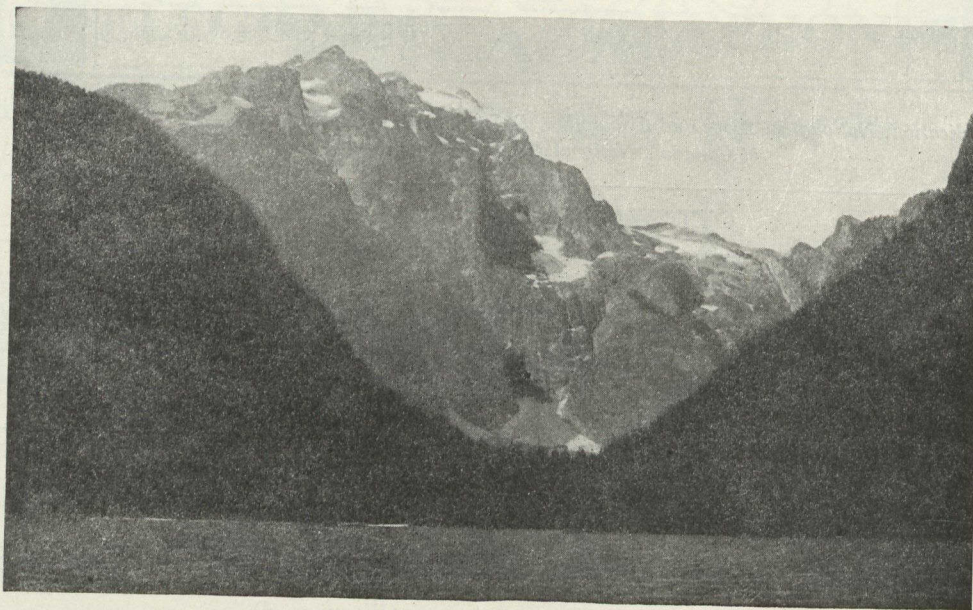


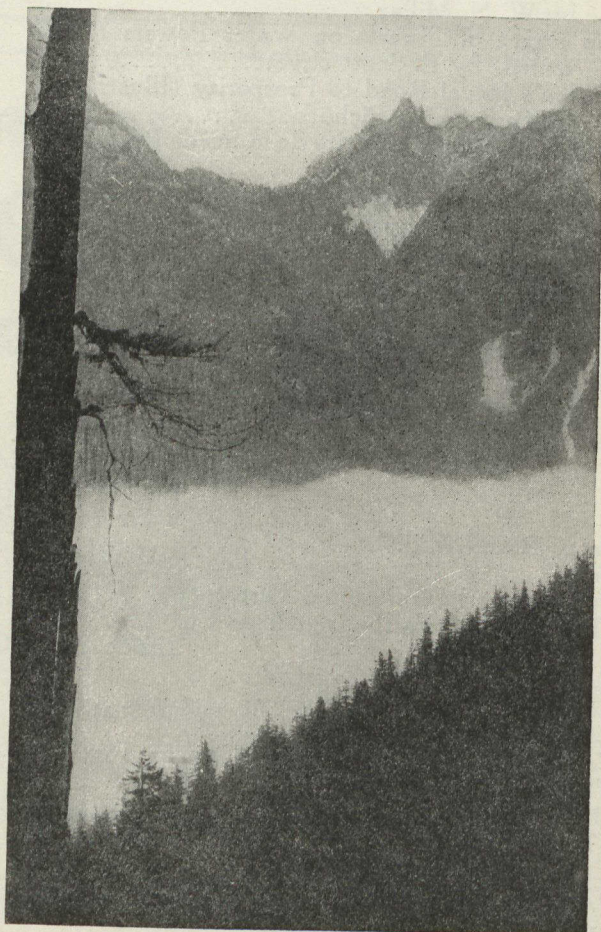
Some Scenic Gems among British Columbia's Mountains, Forests, Rivers, Lakes and Water Falls
