In returning the Accompanying Requisitions for the supply of Indian Presents for the Posts named in the Margin for the current year, to which the Approval of His Excellency The Commander of the Forces has been given, I am directed to call your particular attention to the very extraordinary and serious increase in the demand from the Posts of Drummonds Island and Amherstburg; the former of which, exceeds that of the last year, by no less a sum than nearly Four thousand Pounds Sterling, and the latter by Fifteen Hundred Pounds; for which, no reason being assigned, these Estimates have by His Excellency's direction been reduced to the amount of those authorized for 1819.
