

Ninety pounds Currency, being at the rate of £6090  
 Forty three pounds ten shillings for each family of  
 four persons as detailed in the accompanying  
 Estimate marked A: — This Estimate  
 has been framed upon the understanding that  
 the Indians will be enabled to cut down the  
 Logs required for the Construction of their  
 Houses and to provide upon the spot, a  
 supply of Stone and Lime for the Masonry of their  
 Chimnies. — In the event of the necessary  
 Amount of Provincial funds being granted for  
 this object, (and transferred to the Military  
 Chest, to be accounted for through the  
 Commissary General,) it would be advisable  
 to procure an Order of Council for the  
 Appropriation of Fourteen thousand Acres of  
 Land on the River front of the Isle aux  
 Allumettes, for the Settlement of these  
 Tribes, and that the Commissioner of the Crown  
 Lands, or the Surveyor General, be instructed  
 to cause the necessary Survey thereof to be
