During the month of April last (3) three Indians from Kingcome Inlet sold logs to Mr A.O. Fraser at Kwatsi Bay and for which I hold his due bills amounting to \$72.05. As these were not paid the Indians came to me and asked for advice and assistance, and I wrote to Mr Fraser in regard to the matter and below is his answer which I only received last evening.

Yours of Aug 11 received only a couple of days ago. In reference to them logs I bought from the Indians for the Kwatsi Bay Lumber Co, they have been sold to J.S. Emerson of Vancouver B.C. who bought the mill and logs from the Kwatsi Bay Lbr Co. and if you will write to Mr J.S. Emerson at Vancouver (Fairfield Block) he will forward you a cheque for same. The amount in full due the Indians for the logs is \$72.05 seventy two dollars & 05 cts.

When Mr Emerson bought the logs he promised to pay the Indians at Kwatsi Bay or Broughton Island but it seems he didn't do so.
