Dear Arthur:-

I noticed in today's paper, the enclosed clipping, ascribing to me this resolution. I also received a wire from Merriam, indicating that it was necessary to put this resolution on the order paper at once.

I am not quite sure that it was wise to disclose our hand, in this matter, in the way this resolution does. As a matter of fact, I had in mind making this an "Amendment to the Motion to go into Supply" so that we could have had our "want of confidence" in the Government, in the proposals. As it now stands, of course it is merely a private resolution, which calls for the appointment of a committee, and will give us an opportunity to discuss, but under King's interpretation of parliamentary procedure, would carry no condemnation of the Government.

Will you be kind enough to let me know what is behind the action in putting this on the order paper, so that I can prepare myself for it.
