



Ottawa, October 3, 1907.

Sir,-

In further reference to official letter of the 13th ult., in which you were advised that the Department approved of the proposed expenditure of \$375.00 in sinking and building a well at the source of the water supply for the McDougall Orphanage and that it does not propose to incur further expenditure in connection with this institution at present, I beg to say that the latter paragraph of the letter above referred to is not to be taken too literally, as any absolutely necessary repairs to tide the school over the present season may be made, but repairing on an extensive scale is to be held in abeyance.
