
Ottawa, December 7, 1915.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, in regard to the disposition of boxwood from your reserve, and in reply to say that the local Indian agent was wired on the 2nd instant, to arrange this matter with the Cleveland firm.

I may say that the action by the Department was delayed owing to the fact that it could not be taken until authority had been given by His Royal Highness in Council to the exporting of the timber.
