These things might be done by regulation -

- (1) require that all or part of the civil servants and other employees of the government between the ages of 18 and 40 take military training.
- (2) require that all or part of the employees of factories tendering upon or receiving government contracts between the ages of 18 and 40 take military training.
- (3) require that all persons employed by contractors on government work be those who are prepared to take military training.
- (4) require that any others who may be designated by the Governor General in Council take military training.
- (5) arrange that any others who desire to take military training may do so.

Ph -(

- (6) provide the officers, staffs, equipment, and pay necessary to the above training.
- (7) provide within the terms of the National Resources Mobilization Act that men trained be made available from time to time to the several services into which they may have enlisted.
- (8) provide that those who have snlisted for service be given preference on Federal government works.
- (9) arrange with other government bodies or contractors that those who have enlisted be given first consideration on public works.
- (10) recommend to the Governor General in Council agreements or arrangements with Great Britain or her allies for the supply of food or other products necessary to the proper prosecution of the war.
