Your honor. I am to report such a white people built a mill and cut logs on our reserve at Chemainus Bay, B.C. I.R. 13, with out any permission from the Indians. We often ask Mr. R. H. Moore, indian agent, Duncan, to help us he wont reason. all the logs left is for our own use such as fire wood for the whole band. that is on David Jack's land. Please I want you to stop the whole business as the make great damage on road and bridges which we just finished re-paring it before we left to States to do little work but will be all home next month. thank you.
