him for the land and he will then hand over the papers. Is that it?

- A. Yes.
- Q. Did Mr Bryndilsen and you ever make any written agreement about this land?
- A. We made a paper I had three or four witnesses, among whom were Mr Carleson and Mr Morrow we went into one room and talked it over together. I told Mr Bryndilsen to go and buy the land for me, which he did.
- Q. If you had that 320 acres of land; is that all the land you would need?
- A. That is not much.
- Q. Is it enough?
- A. I want some land outside of that.
- Q. Why did you sell all your cattle?
- A. Because I am getting old.
- Q. Well, you are just as old with the horses how many cattle did you have?
- A. Simty.
- Q. When did you sell them?
- A. Last Fall I sold them all.
- Q. Who bought them?
- A. Bill Clayton and MacFarlane.
- Q. How much did they pay you?
- A. \$47.50 a head.
- Q. m cash.
- A. Yes.
- Q. Well then you have lots of money in the Bank?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Well, you will have lots of money to pay Mr Bryndilsen?
- A. Yes, its alright.
- Q. We will tell Mr Fougner that you have been here and that you say you have the money to pay Mr Bryndilsen for this land, and we will ask Mr Fougner to see you and go with you to Mr Bryndilsen, and I think after that everything will be afright.
