Telegraphers will be granted free transportation Transportations and leave of absence to attend their meetings. Such free transportation will not extend beyond the next section adjoining their Superintendent's district, and the leave of absence will not exceed two days, and will only be granted when it will not interfere with the requirements of the traffic and the service and provided the Company is not thereby put to additional expense.

### Article 7.

When a Telegrapher is transferred by order of Time allowed the proper Official he will suffer no loss of for Transfer schedule wages in consequence thereof, and will be allowed reasonable time (not to exceed four days and without pay) to arrange for the shipment of his household effects.

#### Article 8.

Telegraphers attending Court or investigation at Expenses the request of the proper Official of the Company will have their extra expenses paid by the Company, in addition to their schedule wages.

#### Article 9.

Telegraphers will not be required to teach tele- Students graphy nor admit students, not members of station staff, to their offices.
