ments in connection with the offices held by the Members of the Association, and to expedite the carrying out of the duties of the various Members of the Association for the benefit of that Department of the Govern ment which the Members of the Association serve, as well as for the benefit of the general public.

2. To establish such business relations be tween this Association and the Post-Office Department at Ottawa, that all matters whether concerning ir lividual Members of the Association or the Association itself, may be dealt with through the Association or its Executive Officers.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Any Postmaster in the Province of Ontario shall be eligible for membership in the Association according to such rules as shall be prescribed by this Association.
- 2. Any First Assistant or any acting Postmaster may be eligible for membership in the Association. But such First Assistants may also be admitted where the
