

13. The Candidate shall have publicly delivered three Lectures on subjects in the sciences appointed by the President of Medicine, and shall produce a Candidate from the University that he has produced the appointed Examiners, and is now able to be admitted to the Degree.

Art. XXVI. Of the Degree of Bachelor of Music.

1. No person shall be admitted to the Degree of Bachelor of Music, until he shall have completed the Standing kept the Terms, and passed the Examination prescribed for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts.

2. The Candidate shall have attended during his Residence such Lectures and Instructions as may be specially appointed for Students in Music.

3. He shall produce a Testimonial from the Examining Masters, that he has completed the Standing kept the Terms, and passed the Examination prescribed for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts, and that he has kept the requisite Terms for the Degree of Bachelor of Music, and is now able to be admitted to the Degree of Bachelor of Music.

Art. XXVII. Of the Degree of Doctor of Music.

1. No person shall be admitted to the Degree of Doctor of Music, until he shall have completed three years from the time of his taking the Degree of Bachelor of Music, but Candidates of Seven Years standing from their Matriculation may, by dispensation, be allowed to take the Degree of Doctor immediately after that of Bachelor.

2. The Candidate shall have published a Treatise on the Subject appointed by the President of Medicine, and shall produce a Candidate from the University that he has produced the appointed Examiners, and is now able to be admitted to the Degree.
