This map illustrates the global distribution of the British Empire in 1914. Key features include:

 - Asia:** HONG KONG, SINGAPORE, MALACCA, PENANG, CEYLON, BURMA, INDIA, PAKISTAN, AFGHANISTAN, TURKEY, GREECE, ITALY, FRANCE, SPAIN, PORTUGAL, and the Portuguese Empire (Macau, Timor, East Timor, and various islands in Africa and Asia).
 - Australia and Oceania:** AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND, and various island groups including the Society Islands, Friendly Islands, and the Phoenix Islands.
 - Antarctica:** ANTARCTIC ISLAND, and various smaller islands in the South Atlantic and Indian Oceans.
- Geographical Features:** The Tropic of Cancer, the Equator, and the Tropic of Capricorn are marked. The map also shows the Arctic Circle and the Antarctic Circle.
