



## PROCLAMATION.

**W**HEREAS it hath pleased ALMIGHTY GOD to take to his Mercy out of this troublesome World, our late Sovereign Lord King GEORGE THE FOURTH, of blessed and glorious memory; and His Royal Majesty King WILLIAM THE FOURTH has been proclaimed rightful King of the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, and all other His late Majesty's Dominions: I do declare that the General Assembly of this Province, which now stands prorogued to Thursday the seventh day of October next, is dissolved. And I do hereby notify the Members of the Legislative Council, as well as the Representatives of this His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, severally, as they are returned from the Counties and Townships, that they are discharged from further attendance in the said General Assembly.

And by these Presents, I further declare, that I have THIS DAY given orders to issue Writs, in due form, for calling a New General Assembly, which Writs will bear teste on WEDNESDAY, the 25th instant, and be returnable on MONDAY the eighth day of NOVEMBER next.
