### MEASLES

(Issued by the Department of rublic Health, Nova Scotia.) This common disease is not sually accorded the attention which it should receive. It is a

which it should receive. It is a very serious disease, one which accounts for many deaths in our Province, and which is frequently followed by disabiling after effects.

No age is exempt from measles, although children are more susceptible to it than adults. Contrary to the belief generally held, it is more apt to be fatal in children than in grown people, and it is therefore important that children should be protected from the infection with

tected from the infection with especial care.
