CAMPAGNS IN HIGH ALBANIA

Turks Mobilizing Troops to Conduct Three Simultaneous Operations Against Disaffected Mountaineers.

PROCLAMATION ISSUED ORDERS DISARMAMENT

Guns Must Be Surrendered During Operation of Martial Law—Towers Are to Be Razed

CONSTANTINOPLE, June 10.—There is a talk in the Turkish press of a further concentration and changes in the distribution of the forces with a view to combined simultaneous operations in the interior of High Albania.

The movements indicate that the Albanian Division will operate directly against the Greek rebels from Thessa, while the Stambul and Third Corps Divisions, both augmented by Kodia, and based on Prizren, will move simultaneously against the Dakova and Lyuma tribes. The Turkish Red Division is to disengage at Alessio for Skutari. The operations are planned so as to prevent an Albanian concentration in detail against the Turkish divisions. While the main plans are maturing there will be a minor punitive movement against the Lyuma and Lyuma tribes rising against Prishtina is believed to have upset the co-ordinated plans for a more general and simultaneous Albanian revolt.

Disarmament Proclamation The disarmament proclamation requires the Albanians to surrender all arms and sporting guns, which are to remain under Government seal until the withdrawal of martial law. The troops engaged in the house search are enjoined to treat the inhabitants with all gentleness while the civil functionaries assess the armament of each household. One week's grace is allowed for the surrender of arms, and the expiration of that period non-compliance will be punished with the torch. The loop-holes in the wall openings must be opened up as windows uniformly one metre square, otherwise the towers will be razed. They have condemned the Albanian rebels to hang. The Minister of War, however, is delaying the execution of the sentences.

Concentrating Troops The Turkish Government had already concentrated 35,000 troops in High Albania. It is now disclosed that this is not the full extent of the mobilization of the army necessary to deal with the rebellious mountaineers. Eight more battalions of the active army are to be transferred from the Adriatic Army Corps and a further large mobilization of Asiatic reserve battalions is in progress. By the time these latter troops have reached the base of operations under arms in Albania, they will have nearly 50,000 men. Their relations with their subjects in the Kosova Vilayet have justified this great military concentration. The Turkish Government alone can say. Nothing but the utmost urgency could warrant the monetary expenditure in that these operations must entail in the present state of the Ottoman Empire. Over and above the financial consideration there is the uncertainty that must always attach to the issues of a civil war.

Double Tracking Line The C.P.R. is preparing to continue the double tracking of its line between Portage la Prairie and Brandon. J. G. Hargrave & Co., who recently completed the sub-grade work on the section of the line from Winnipeg to Portage la Prairie, have been instructed to continue west, and will proceed at once. This announcement was made yesterday by Mr. Whyte.
