THE VALUE OF HUMAN BLOOD.

A Singular Case Growing Out of a Case of Transfusion.

From the New York Times.

On the night of Feb. 17, C. J. V. Okenberg, a clerk in the employ of the Western Union Telegraph company, engaged a room under assumed name at the St. Andrew hotel, and upon retiring blew out the gas.

He was found in a condition of advanced asphyxiation, and lay for hours in an unconscious condition. Drs. Garrigue, Valentine and Anderson were summoned to attend him, and, after consultation, decided that the only way to save the man's life

was by transfusing him with blood from another individual and thus get rid of the excess of carbon in his system. The proprietor of the hotel was accordingly instructed to hunt up a healthy subject who was willing to undergo the operation, and a colored porter, named Edward Banks, was called upon.

The proposed subject was by no means inclined to serve at first, but when he was told that only about eight or ten drops of his blood would be needed, he consented, and the blood would be paid for at the rate of 10 cents a drop, his cupidly overcame his fears, and he submitted his arm to the instrument. Dr. Garrigue drew eight ounces of the vital fluid, and transfused it into the arm of the patient, who rapidly convalesced. Banks afterward a rival Okenberg, as nurse, and claims that the latter gentleman was so overcome by a sense of the obligation which he owed to his preserver that he promised to award him to his satisfaction. All that Banks received, however, was a \$5 note in discharge of all obligations, and accordingly he brought suit for \$250, which his counsel claimed was the value of the blood at the price agreed upon, 10 cents a drop, together with the value of the nursing given the sick man by the plaintiff. It was estimated that an ounce of blood contained 40 drops, and eight ounces at 10 cents a drop would thus be appraised at \$192, the value of the attendance, etc., bringing the bill up to \$250.

The case came up yesterday in the sixth district court before Justice Kelly, without a jury. Banks was the first witness. He is an ebony-skinned negro, with the purest Virginia accent. He gave a somewhat prolix account of the part taken by him in the surgical operation, and said that he had been given to understand that he would receive 10 cents for his blood. He had attended to the patient for several days and nights, and had expended 90 cents in beer, cake and newspapers for Mr. Okenberg. "I told him," he said, "as soon as he was healed, I'd get my money, and he said, 'Dat's all right, I will reward you for your assistance.'"

The defendant, however, said that he had signed by Banks for \$5 in full for all services rendered. Banks said that he had signed it supposing it was only a receipt for the \$5, and not a receipt in full. He was unable to read, and had only been told what he was signing. An examination followed to test his abilities in the way of reading and writing, which did not appear to amount to much.

Dr. Garrigue was next examined. He gave a disquisition upon methods of transfusing blood, and said that if blood could not be procured it was a good plan to transfuse a solution of albumen and water into the veins. Dr. Valentine testified that he had not, as was alleged, promised to pay ten cents a drop for the blood, but he had had an indistinct recollection that something was said in a joking way to that effect. Neither himself, Anderson, or Garrigue had received any payment for their services. He said that blood had no commercial value, but in this case, as given to save his life, he thought it should be considered as valuable.

Okenberg testified in his own defense that he had not authorized the physicians to take blood from Banks' arm, nor to make any contract for him; neither had he promised Banks to reward him. He was a poor man, and on receiving \$50 per month as a clerk in the Western Union company. His wife had nursed him after the first day of his illness and not Banks. He admitted that Banks had bought beer and cake for him, but considered that payment for these articles was included in the \$5 he had given him. Decisions in this case were reserved, and will be rendered in a few days.
