IN THE LAND OF THE LAMAS.

Experiences of a Journey from Cashmere to Chinese Territory. Captain Bower, of the Seventeenth Bengal cavalry, and Dr. Thoburn reached Shanghai on April 1, having journeyed from Cashmere through Tibet up the Chinese province of Szechwan, an exploit without parallel by Europeans. The greater part of the journey was made at an altitude of 15,000 feet above the sea, and for a fortnight the road was 17,000 feet above the level. The party, which consisted of Captain Bower, Dr. Thoburn and nine East Indians, spent just a year on the journey, eight months of which were passed in the elevated country that is seldom visited by Europeans. A part of their route was traversed by the American explorer Hooker and by Prince Henri of Orléans and M. de Goyenaux, but the New York Sun thinks no previous explorers had the same opportunity for observation.
