

The Government of Canada and  
the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany,

Conscious of their obligations under the North Atlantic  
Treaty of 4 April 1949,

Convinced that the defence capabilities of the North  
Atlantic Alliance will be enhanced by Host Nation Support  
during times of crisis or war,

Under the provisions of the Agreement of 19 June 1951  
between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty Regar-  
ding the Status of their Forces (NATO SOFA) and the  
Agreement of 3 August 1959 to Supplement the Agreement  
between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regar-  
ding the Status of their Forces with respect to Foreign  
Forces stationed in the Federal Republic of Germany  
(Supplementary Agreement),

Have agreed as follows:

#### Article 1

##### Type and Extent of Canadian Commitments

1. Consonant with paragraph 2 of Article 1 of the Con-  
vention on the Presence of Foreign Forces in the  
Federal Republic of Germany dated 23 October 1954, in  
times of crisis or war, the Government of Canada  
in agreement with the Government of the Fede-  
ral Republic of Germany intends to reinforce its
