Article I: General Provisions On Scope

This article includes all the obligations with which a Party to the CWC agrees to comply.

Article II: Definitions And Criteria

This article will eventually deal only with definitions and criteria, but the interim definition on chemical weapons does have an obligation in bracketed language by which State Parties would agree not to utilize chemicals which would enhance the effect of chemical weapons.

Article III: Declarations

Declarations are required on Chemical Weapons,
Chemical Weapons Production Facilities, and on other
facilities under the heading of Other Declarations. The first
two declarations are directed at possessors and producers.
The reporting dates [1 January 1946] [26 March 1975] have been
proposed for chemical weapons and [1 January 1946] for
chemical weapon production facilities. This reporting
requirement concerning information on past activities would
necessitate that a number of potential State Parties conduct a
detailed review of past records.
