

## ANNEX I

### LIST OF PROHIBITED FOOD OR SUBSTANCES

#### 1. Substances Prohibited From Use In Food

- Salicylic acid. Notification No. 4 (1979)
- Boric Acid
- Borax
- Calcium iodate and Potassium iodate (except for the use of goitre prevention and remedy)
- Nitrofurazone
- Potassium chlorate
- Formaldehyde Solution and Paraformaldehyde. Notification No. 93 (1985) --  
Coumarin, or 1,2-Benzopyrone or 5,6-Benzopyrone, or Cis-O-coumaric acid anhydride or O-Hydroxycinnamic acid, lactone. Notification No. 112 (1987)
- Dihydro coumarin or benzo-dihydropyrone or 3,4-Dihydrocoumarin or Hydrocoumarin
- Methyl Alcohol or Methanol. Notification no. 123 (1989)

#### 2. Food prohibited to be Manufactured, Imported or Distributed. Notification No. 112 (1988)

- Dulcin, or para-phenetolecarbamide
- Cyclamic acid and its salts, (except salts of cyclamic acid which is sodium cyclamate)
- AF-2, or furylframide, or 2-(2-furyl)-3-(5-nitro-2-furyl) acrylamide
- Food containing dulcin, AF-2 or cyclamic acid and its salts (except those using salts of cyclamic acid which is sodium cyclamate)

#### 3. Food Prohibited to be Produced, Imported or Distributed. Notification No. 126 (1989)

- Food which contains Daminozide or succinic acid 2, 2- dimethylhydrazide, (Alar)
