AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL

FOR CO-OPERATION IN THE PEACEFUL USES

OF NUCLEAR ENERGY

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA (hereinafter referred to as Canada) and THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL (hereinafter referred to as Brazil), both hereinafter referred to as the "Parties";

DESIRING to strengthen the friendly relations that exist between the Parties;

MINDFUL of the advantages of effective co-operation in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy;

RECOGNIZING that Canada is a non-nuclear-weapon State party to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons done at London, Moscow and Washington on July 1, 1968, (hereinafter referred to as the "NPT") and, as such, has undertaken not to manufacture or otherwise acquire nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices and that Canada has concluded an agreement with the International Atomic Energy Agency to accept safeguards on all source or special fissionable material in all peaceful nuclear activities within its territory, under its jurisdiction or carried out under its control anywhere, for the exclusive purpose of verifying that such material is not diverted to nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices;

RECOGNIZING that Brazil is a State party to the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and in the Caribbean and, as such, has undertaken to use exclusively for peaceful purposes the nuclear material and facilities which are under its jurisdiction, and party to the Agreement between Brazil and the Republic of Argentina for the Exclusively Peaceful Use of Nuclear Energy, and that Brazil has concluded an agreement with the International Atomic Energy Agency, the Republic of Argentina and the Brazilian-Argentine Agency for Accounting and Control of Nuclear Materials to accept safeguards on all source or special fissionable material in all peaceful nuclear activities within its territory, under its jurisdiction or carried out under its control anywhere, for the exclusive purpose of verifying that such material is not diverted to nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices;

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

For the purpose of this Agreement:

(a) "The Agency's Safeguards System" means the safeguards system set out in the International Atomic Energy Agency document INFCIRC/66 Rev 2 as well as any subsequent amendments thereto that are accepted by the Parties;
