5. Choose Apply to make your changes and leave the dialog box open or choose OK to make your changes and close the dialog box.

To change the mouse double-click speed:

- 1. From the Start menu, choose Settings.
- 2. From the Settings submenu, choose Control Panel.
- 3. In the Control Panel window, double-click the Mouse icon.
- 4. In the Mouse Properties dialog box, on the Buttons page, in the Double-click speed area, drag the slider to the desired position.
- 5. Choose OK.

To change the mouse tracking speed:
