M. FATIN RUSTU ZORLU, Permanent Representative to the North Atlantic Council, with the rank of Ambassador

Born 1910. Educated at the Galata-Saray College and Geneva University. Entered the Turkish Foreign Service in 1932 and served successively in Berne, Paris, Moscow and Beirut.

In 1947 and 1948 Turkish delegate to the United Nations Trade Conference at Havana and in 1949 to the European Economic Recovery Conference in Paris.

Before taking up his post at the North Atlantic Council, M. Zorlu was Deputy Secretary General for Economic Affairs and Secretary General of the Organization for International Economic Co-operation at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Ankara.

On April 2nd, 1954, M. Zorlu was elected to the Turkish parliament and appointed Deputy Prime Minister, while retaining his appointment as Permanent Representative to the North Atlantic Council.

M. Zorlu is married and has one daughter.
