The House then resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Matthews for an Address to His Excellency the Governor General, in reply to his speech at the opening of the Session, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Manion in amendment thereto, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Woodsworth in amendment to the said proposed amendment.

And the Debate still continuing; the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. McNiven, adjourned.

Mr. Dunning, a Member of the King's Privy Council, delivered a Message from His Excellency the Governor General which was read by Mr. Speaker, as follows:—

TWEEDSMUIR

The Governor General transmits to the House of Commons, Estimates of sums required for the service of the Dominion for the year ending on the 31st March, 1940, and, in accordance with the provisions of "The British North America Act, 1867," the Governor General recommends these Estimates to the House of Commons.
